Current Transformers Current transformers (CT's) provide a simple, inexpensive and yet accurate means of sensing current flow in power conductors They are available in 3 basic configurations: 1 Ring Core CT's are available for measuring currents from 50 to 5000 amps, with windows (power conductor opening size) from 1" to 8" diameter 2

Current Transformer White Paper The Basics of Current Transformers Ratio The CT ratio is the ratio of primary current input to secondary current output at full load For example, a CT with a ratio of 300:5 is rated for 300 primary amps at full load and will produce 5 amps of secondary current when 300 amps flow through the primary

This safety zone or setback allowance, combined with the "shape" of the time-current characteristic curve, results in selection of a current-limiting fuse ampere rating substantially greater than the transformer full-load current.

3.5.2 Selection and Rating of Transformers

according to the harmonic spectrum of the load current and is an indication of the additional eddy current load losses. It reflects the excess losses experienced in a traditional wire wound transformer. Modern transformers use alternative winding designs such as foil windings or mixed wire/foil windings.
